VII. PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act #299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except:

When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 square feet in area. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

VIII. FEE CLARIFICATIONS

ITEM #17, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE:

When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites. When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor.

When setting a HUD mobile home or a premanufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.

When ready for an Inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the **job location** and **permit number**.

"Section 23a of the State Construction Codes Act of 1972, Act no 230 of public Act 1972, being Section 125.1523a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this State relating to persons who perform work on residential buildings or a residential structure. Violators of Section 23a are subjected to civil fines."

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled permits cannot be refunded or reinstated.

- ✓ 48 HOUR NOTICE REQUIRED FOR INSPECTIONS.
- A permit must be taken out before work is started and this office must be notified when work is completed.
- ✓ Any changes in plans or specifications MUST be approved by electrical inspector.
