



ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

to be placed in the Berlin Township recycling bin

Plastic Bottles (#1 - 7) including:

- Milk Jugs
- Water Bottles

Paper including:

- Paper bags without a plastic liner
- Manila Folders
- Envelopes
- Shredded Paper
- Color Ledger Paper
- Post-Its
- Phone Books
- Newspaper
- Brochures & Magazines



The recycling bin is emptied at various times on Tuesday & Friday (may be delayed during holidays).

How to prepare your recyclables:
Empty. Clean. Dry.

Keep all recyclables free of food & liquid.

Do NOT throw plastic bags into the bin!
(Place empty bags into the blue receptacle to the left of the recycling bins)

Aluminum Cans

All Cardboard (boxes **MUST BE** broken down & flat)

Chip Board including:

- Cereal Boxes
- Empty Paper Towel & Toilet Paper Rolls

****FOOD RESIDUE SHOULD BE RINSED OUT FROM ALL ITEMS****



NEVER place these items in the recycling bin!

We have found all of these items in our recycling bin!! Please dispose of these items with your local garbage pickup or at a Berlin Charter Township Free Dump Day held every spring and fall.

“WHEN IN DOUBT, LEAVE IT OUT!”

The township will incur contamination fees if these rules are not followed. The trucks that empty our bins are equipped with cameras and we will be notified of any contamination resulting in fees of \$200 or more *per bin*. Continued misuse will require a review of the recycling program.
